SUBJECT: Army National Guard (ARNG) Supplement to Department of Defense Activity Address Code (DODAAC) Management in Global Combat Support System–Army (GCSS-Army) Wave 1 Environment

1. References:

 - d. NARR//ALARACT: Update 1 to ALARACT 350/2012, Department of Defense Activity Address Code (DODAAC) Management in Global Combat Support System-Army (GCSS-Army) Wave 1 Environment.
2. The purpose of this memorandum is to supplement DODAAC Policy in Support of Supply Operations in a GCSS-Army enabled enterprise environment to reflect ARNG Operations.
3. States/Territories should identify all unused DODAACs (to include Sierra Army Depot (SIAD) DODAACs) that can be realigned to a new requirement before requesting new DODAACs. States/Territories can submit DODAAC requests after they have completed a review of available DODAACs.
4. The National Guard will track data cleansing and DODAAC alignment to ensure All States/Territories pursue new DODAAC assignment/realignment only for valid requirements.
5. The United States Army Materiel Command (USAMC) Logistics Support Agency (LOGSA) has the authority to establish any new valid requirement General Fund Enterprise Business System (GFEBS) DODAACs at D-300. States/Territories will finalize GCSS-Army and GFEBS Customer DODAACs at D-180.

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6. States/Territories will align the Cannibalization Point (CP) DODAAC to GCSS-Army. (This is applicable only when the CP is approved by ARNG-ILS-M.)

7. States/Territories will ensure the Central Issue Facility - Installation Support Module (CIF-ISM) (W7**25 Unit Identification Code (UIC)) and United States Property and Fiscal Office (USPFO) (W7**54 UIC) Transformation Account DODAACs are aligned to GCSS-Army. The USPFO Transformation Account will be coded **non-requisitioning**.

8. States/Territories will ensure the following DODAACs remain aligned to GFEBS (Fiscal Station Number (FSN) 21001):

(a) USPFO Billing

(b) Central Clothing Distribution Facility (CCDF)

(c) Initial Entry Training (IET) Clothing (Active Duty Training Pay Group F)

(d) Initial Entry Training (IET) Clothing (Inactive Duty Training Pay Group P)

(e) Defense Logistics Agency Disposition Services (DLADS)

(f) Contracting Officer (KO)

(g) Fuels Automated System (FAS)

(h) Ammunition Supply Point (ASP)

(i) Multi-use at the USPFO (AA) Level (may be used for CL 1, CL III (Bulk), CL VI, CL VIII and Local Purchase (LP)) for the split-state units where the State has only derivative UICs assigned to their State.

(j) Multi-use at the (AA) UIC Level (may be used for CL I, CL III (Bulk), CL VI, CL VIII and LP).

(k) Note 1 – DODAACs referenced above in paragraph 8(a) through 8(h) are already assigned and will continue to be utilized for GFEBS.

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(I) Note 2 – In some States – DODAACs referenced above in paragraph 8(a) through 8(e) or a combination of may be the same DODAAC.

9. States/Territories will ensure all other DODAACs currently in GFEBs and used for MILSTRIP are realigned to GCSS-Army FSN (13145). All other DODAACs in GFEBs not in paragraph 8 above will be **DELETED**.

10. States/Territories will ensure all DODAACs not used in GCSS-Army or GFEBs for a valid requirement are **DELETED**.

11. Newly assigned/realigned DODAACs may be used **IMMEDIATELY** upon receipt.
